This ensures proper cluster communication between the nodes. Stepscluster ha modify -configured true If storage failover is not already enabled, you will be prompted to confirm enabling of both storage failover and auto-giveback. set -privilege advanced Confirm when prompted to continue into advanced mode. The advanced mode prompt appears (*>). network options switchless-cluster show If the output shows that the value is false, you must issue the following command: network options switchless-cluster modify true set -privilege admin
